Entry Fee: \$35.00 per person, per event

Breakdown: Prize Fund \$24.00 (Returned 100%) Bowling Fees and Tournament Expenses \$11.00

All Events: \$5.00 (optional) per person, Scratch/Handicap

Optional: Scratch Team, Scratch Doubles, Scratch Singles (\$10.00 per bowler, per event)

PRE-PAID ENTRIES WILL HAVE FIRST PRIORITY OF DATES AND TIMES.

All Prize Funds, per event, will be distributed at a 1:5 ratio.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Only USBC certified members of the Greater Hamilton USBC (GHUSBC) are eligible to bowl in this tournament. Any bowler who is a USBC member, but not a GHUSBC member must purchase a local membership for \$10.00, prior to the start of their shift. Non-members of USBC may enter by paying a Standard membership fee of \$27.00 (becoming a member of USBC & GHUSBC local). USBC rules will govern this tournament, except as stated below.
2. This is a handicap tournament. Bowlers will get 90% of the difference between their entering average and 220 (3 game basis).
3. a) All bowlers must use their highest 21 game or more USBC average as follows: 2023-24 seasons, including summer; if none, the highest current 2024-25 average as of February 1, 2025 (proof must be provided); if none the bowler will enter with a 220 as an entering average (no handicap).
b) Challenge/Sports League average adjustments will apply per USBC Rule 319-c.
c) Each captain is responsible for their team and must submit their bowlers' highest averages.
d) Bowlers do not have to report prize winnings from last year.
e) The tournament committee reserves the right to re-rate a bowler's average prior to participation, per USBC Rule 319c.
4. Bowlers may enter only the Team Event, Doubles Event, or Singles Event. They do not have to enter all the events. A team may only bowl once in the Team Event. However, a team may change at least one bowler and enter as a new team. You may re-enter the Doubles Event by changing partners and bowling as a new team.
5. If you enter the Doubles & Singles Event on the same shift, you will bowl the doubles first, then your singles. You can split your Doubles and Singles events by submitting separate entry forms for each event. You can only enter the Singles Event one time.
6. Entry Fee for a 4-member team is \$140.00, Doubles Team \$70.00 and Singles \$35.00. These fees include the cost of bowling, prize money and expenses for each Team/Doubles/Singles event. There will be an optional Handicap All-Events offered for bowlers with a 219 average or less, as well as an optional Scratch All-Events for an additional fee of \$5.00 for each All-Event (all prize money). SCRATCH OPTIONS are available for TEAM (\$40.00), DOUBLES (20.00), AND SINGLES (10.00) Events. (all prize money).
7. No phone reservations or spots will be held without an entry form being submitted. Availability will be on a first paid priority basis up to 30 minutes prior to the start of a shift. The Greater Hamilton USBC will not be held responsible for lost or mis-directed entries. Walk-ins will be allowed on a first come first served basis.

8. A Team Captain may substitute other bowlers to take the place of those who entered but could not bowl as scheduled. Team handicaps will be changed accordingly when substitutes are used to replace original entrants.
9. In the Team Event, Team Captains must check in at the Tournament Office 30 minutes before the start of their shift. In the Doubles and Singles Event, each entrant must check-in at the Tournament Office.
The check-in desk will open 1 hour before the start of each shift. No walk-in/new entries 30 minutes prior to the start of a shift.
10. Teams or individuals who are not on the lanes ready to bowl when scheduled may forfeit their entry fee, subject to the discretion of the Tournament Committee. If the Tournament Committee allows a tardy bowler to compete, that bowler will start the game in the frame then being bowled and will score zero for all frames missed.
11. When checking in for the Team Event and Doubles & Singles Events, team captains will be given their team's lane assignments. If two teams wish to cross lanes with one another, entries should be submitted at the same time indicating such. There will be no lane changes in the team event or doubles & singles event. You will remain on your starting lanes for the entire set, unless mechanical failure requires a move to another pair of lanes.
