Tournament Rules:

1. Open to youth bowlers who **have not** reached their 18th birthday before August 1, 2026.
2. Must be a member of the Greater Hamilton USBC to participate. Members of other Associations may participate by paying the appropriate service fee. (\$1.00)
3. Eligible participants who are not USBC members can qualify by paying the appropriate association membership dues. (\$5.00) To be eligible for the Junior Gold Qualifier an individual must purchase a Junior Gold Membership prior to bowling.
4. Handicap will be 90 percent of 220.
5. ****Entering Average:****
 - a. Highest 2026-2027 or 2025-2026 USBC Youth league average or current High School average of at least 9 games (*summer included*).
 - b. If using a current average, must be 9 games or more by March 6th, 2027. **A standing sheet showing your USBC Youth average, a signed average verification by a responsible league official or association manager, or proof of high school bowling average from high school conference will be proof of average.**
 - c. Bowlers without a minimum 9 game USBC Youth league or High School average must bowl scratch. (220)
6. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average and handicap whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. If an error occurs in the classification of a bowler which is detected prior to payout, a correction will be made, and the scores recalculated without penalty.
7. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with [Rule 329](#).
8. Teams may consist of any combination of male/female youth members.
9. A team may substitute a bowler to take the place of those who entered but could not bowl as scheduled. Handicaps will be changed accordingly when substitutes are used to replace original entrants.
10. Each team must check-in at the Tournament Table which will open 1 hour before the start of each shift.
11. When checking in, team captains will be given their team's lane assignments. You will stay on the same lanes for all three games.
12. Teams or individuals who are not on the lanes ready to bowl when scheduled may forfeit their entry fee, subject to the discretion of the Tournament Committee. If the Tournament Committee allows a tardy bowler to compete, that bowler will start the game in progress in the frame currently being bowled and will receive zero for all frames missed.
13. A bowler may enter only the Team Event, Doubles Event, or Singles Event. They do **NOT** have to enter all the events.
14. A team may only bowl once in the Team Event; however, a team can change at least **one** bowler and enter again as a new team. Any individual may bowl all shifts in the Doubles Events but must change partners. An individual can bowl the Singles Event multiple times.
15. If you enter the Doubles & Singles Event on the same shift, you will bowl Doubles first, then your Singles. You can split your Doubles & Singles Events by submitting separate entry forms for each event.
16. Lanes will be reconditioned after each shift.
17. There will be an all-events option, handicap and/or scratch for an additional \$5.00 each.
18. An optional Scratch Singles will be available for an additional \$15.00.
19. An optional Junior Gold Qualifier will be available for an additional \$40 entry. Scratch scores rolled in the entrants first event will be used for qualifying. (1:6 bowlers will advance) Ties will be determined by a 10th frame roll-off.
20. You can drop off to any of the GHUSBC bowling centers by March 13th.
